Procedure to Follow:

1. Obtain form **RP-524** Complaint on Real Property Assessment for 20__

2. Complete entire form with appropriate information (4 pages). Page 4 must be signed.

3. Submit RP-524 to Assessor's Office by **May 23, 2017**.
 - If you are requesting a Board of Assessment Review hearing, you must submit the completed RP-524 Complaint form **BEFORE** an appointment will be scheduled. Please submit all supporting **documentation*** with your complaint form.
***You are required to submit proof necessary to determine the value of your property. Assessments are based on the market value of your property. Sales of similar property are the best proof of value. See RP-524-Ins page 2 Part 2**
****Please note, we will begin taking appointments May 1, 2017. The earlier you make your appointment, the better your choice of appointment.**
 - If you are requesting a non-hearing, the RP-524 must be submitted along with supporting **documentation** by **May 23, 2017**. The Board of Assessment Review will make a determination based on the complaint form and any supporting documentation submitted.
 - Property information and any informal review documents you may have submitted earlier this year will be made available to the Board of Assessment Review upon request.
4. Appear at your scheduled hearing.
5. Board of Assessment Review Determination Notices will be mailed by **June 22, 2017**.

If you are satisfied with the Board of Assessment determination, there is nothing further you have to do. The assessment from this determination will apply to the School bill in October, 2017 and the County/Town bill in February, 2018.
